- 4. DRAW will take place at 8:00 a.m. Tuesday, June 20 at the home of the Field Trial Secretary.

All dogs will run in the order drawn.

- 5. The starting dog number in the first series of the Open on Saturday and Sunday will be determined by using the last two digits (including digits, if any, to the right of the decimal point) at closing of the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSE) S&P/TSX composite index on the Thursday immediately preceding the trial.
- 6. A separate entry form for EACH dog in EACH stake is required (Official CKC Entry Form)
- 7. All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee (and listing fee if applicable). The listing fee of \$10.50 (GST included) per dog per event is payable unless the entered dog has a CKC individual registration number or an ERN number.

Standard CKC rosettes to all dogs placing in each stake.

Certificate of Merit awards at the Judges' discretion

A system of rotation will be used in the All Age Stakes

SCRATCHES
