GENERAL CLUB MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

1. This is a **WORKING MEMBER RETRIEVER CLUB** and we expect all Members to contribute to the general maintenance of the club land and assisting in Club Events. This club belongs to you the membership, so please help out.

There are many jobs that must be done including general grounds maintenance, campground maintenance, working at club events, equipment maintenance, and organizational committee work.

Members will receive periodic emails asking for volunteers. Please volunteer.

<u>Grounds maintenance</u>: cutting points and mounds, picking foxtail, weed control, filling gopher and badger holes, roads upkeep, pumping ponds, etc.

<u>Campground maintenance</u>: cutting grass, trimming branches, hauling water, clubhouse cleaning, outhouses, etc.

Working at events: organizing, marshalling, throwing, judging, meals prep etc.

- 2. The Club House is always left open and available for member use. If you do use the Club House please make sure to clean up after yourself. The Club has a fridge and freezer which members can use while at the grounds, but please do not leave food behind to spoil. One fridge has cold drinks and water in it available for sale (\$1.00). Please place money in dish.
- 3. We have the best outhouses on the trial circuit. Please keep them clean and tidy. Make sure that the door is securely closed when you leave.
- 4. The front gates are kept locked but the side gates are unlocked. Please close gates and lock the front gate when you are the last to leave the property.
- 5. The gate at the Lost River Property should always be kept closed when not in use. Please close it when you leave.
- 6. **PLEASE STAY ON THE ROADS/TRAILS** and do not drive across the grass etc.
- 7. Please remember to pick up all "Blind" markers and trash.
- 8. Discard used birds in the bird dump, not in the Loraas bin. Only bagged garbage should be placed in the Loraas bin.
- 9. If you discover a dangerous badger hole during training please fill it in or at least mark it so it can be filled in later. These holes are a serious danger to our dogs. A supply of stakes can be found on the East side of the Containers feel free to take a few with you when training.

10. RV Camping is available on the grounds. The fee is \$15.00 per night whether or not the camper is occupied. There is a camping fee box located in the Club House for cheques or cash but whenever possible camping fees should be paid by Etransfer saskatoonretrieverclub@gmail.com and put CAMPING in the comments.

Club members can choose to pay an annual camping fee of \$75.00 for the summer season instead of the \$15.00 per night charge.

Be aware that the electrical service for each RV site is only 15 amps shared between two trailers. Lights, electronics and water pumps are fine but refrigerators, heaters, air conditioners, hot water heaters, etc should be run on propane instead of electrical.

Whenever possible, RV trailers that are not in use (will not be entered by owner) for 7 days or more should be unplugged to decrease electricity usage.

During the dates of scheduled club events (tests, trials, seminars) members who are not participating in or working at the event may be required to move their trailers to overflow (North of the campground, North of the trail) so the electrified camping sites can be available for participants.

- 11. Air dogs in the field West of the campground. Accidents in the campground area should be cleaned up immediately.
- 12. NO OPEN FIRES except at the fire pit East of the Club House. Propane fire pits at the campers are acceptable. No fires when the municipality of Blucher has a fire ban in place will be posted in Clubhouse.
- 13. The SRC Membership year is from January 1st to December 31st. Memberships are due before January 1st. Current membership renewal fee is \$150.00
