

SASKATOON RETRIEVER CLUB CAMPING INFO FOR VISITORS

1. Upon arrival, park your camper in the site you have been assigned. A master list may be posted on the white board in the Clubhouse or the sites will be marked.
2. Once your trailer is parked, trucks and other vehicles should not be parked in the campground area. Park west of the trees by the road.
3. Be aware that the electrical service for each site is only 15 amps at each outlet (shared between two trailers). Basic lights, electronics and water pumps are fine but refrigerators, heaters, air conditioners, hot water heaters, etc should all be run on propane instead of electrical.
4. If you blow a breaker, check the master list in the clubhouse, find your unit's breaker in the Clubhouse or in the Duck freezer shed, and reset the tripped breaker or get someone to help.
5. Pumpouts may be periodically available for a fee during week-long events.
6. Water fills can be arranged from the Club large water tank but NOTE that this water should not be considered potable as it has been sitting in the tank.
7. No open wood campfires at individual trailers – use the campfire area East of the Clubhouse. No fires if there is a fire ban posted.
8. Please do not use the refrigerators and freezers in the Clubhouse for personal food and drink
9. Place bagged garbage in the dumpster – NO BIRDS! Discarded birds go to the Bird dump.
10. Pick up all dog poop in the campground area and fill any holes dug by your dogs. Do not tie dogs to trees.
11. Pay camping fees by E transfer to saskatoonretrieverclub@gmail.com and put CAMPING in the comments. Alternatively pay by cheque or cash in the small envelopes provided in the blue box inside the Clubhouse - write your name and number of nights on the envelope. Camping is \$15/night.
